
Pharmaceutical care in Austria: A survey on services provided by community pharmacies

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Community pharmacy is evolving internationally: is this also true for Austria?

- Background: Internationally, the role of community pharmacies has evolved beyond dispensing, counselling, and producing medicines, moving towards pharmaceutical care (i.e. improving patient outcomes through medicines optimisation).
- Study aim: To survey the range of community pharmacy services provided in Austria and to understand the role of community pharmacies in the Austrian health system.
- Methods: Two-stage, representative survey of services provided in community pharmacies in Austria, conducted in 2023
 - Stage 1: detailed tracking of activities for one week in 25 pharmacies (January 2023)
 - Stage 2: national online survey among pharmacists working in community pharmacies on services provided and time spent on each service (March 2023)

Community pharmacies in Austria tend to focus on core pharmacy services



- Core pharmacy services are provided by the vast majority of community pharmacists in Austria, including dispensing of medicines and counselling (99.7% of participants) as well as compounding (90.1%). Medication review was provided by 40.1% of participating pharmacists.
- Jointly, medicines related services accounted for 81.0% of the time spent by participating pharmacists on all documented services.
- The remaining 19.0% of the time was spent on non-medicines related services, including testing, referring patients to other health care providers, and health promotion.


Pharmacy testing was dominated by COVID-19 tests

- While community pharmacies throughout Austria commonly offer various health tests (including for blood pressure, blood sugar, and other parameters), median weekly test numbers were a fraction of the tests conducted for COVID-19 and other infectious diseases.
- Overall, this survey showed that community pharmacies in Austria have not fully transitioned towards providing pharmaceutical care.
- Changes to the legal framework in Austria introduced in 2024 allow for an expanded role with additional competencies for medicines optimisation and testing. The effects of these reforms on patient and health system outcomes should be evaluated.
