Take Home Naloxon Projects in Austria

- 2018: Styria (Graz)
 - Low-threshold centre (Kontaktladen & Streetwork, Caritas)
- 2019: Vienna
 - Low-threshold centre (Viennese Ambulatorium and Jedmayer services)
- 2020: Burgenland (Eisenstadt)
 - specifically oriented towards young drug users (coordinated by the Child and Youth Psychiatry and Psychotherapy Centre of Eisenstadt)
- 2022: Carinthia
 - Based on training of multiplicators (social workers, therapist, advisors) who train people who use drugs in several Carinthian drug outpatient clinics and drug counselling facilities
- 2022: Vorarlberg (Bregenz, Dornbirn, Feldkirch, Bludenz)
 - Low-threshold centres (do it yourself, Caritas, Ex und Hopp, dowas)
- 2023: Tyrol (Innsbruck, Hall in Tyrol)
 - Based on training of multiplicators (social workers, therapist, advisors) who train people who use drugs in
 - several drug counselling facilities (*Mentlvilla, KomFüDro, abrakadabra, baseCamp mobil*)
 - drug outpatient clinic of the Department of Psychiatry at Innsbruck University Hospital and
 - specialized unit for drug therapy of the provincial hospital Hall in Tyrol.

THN projects in 6 out of nine Austrian Federal States



Is this sufficient?

- Rather small projects there is no systematic monitoring (e.g., how many kits are distributed)
- The number of kits should be set in relation to the number of problem drug users ("to be prepared"; new indicator for EUDA?)
- The essential question is: How likely is it that Naloxon will be available in the event of opioid overdose?
- Groups to be focused on in the future:
 - Patients in OAT
 - People who use drugs in prison
 - People who use drugs surviving an intoxication

Drug Checking Projects in Austria

Vienna: checkit!

- 1997: launch of research project in collaboration with the clinical toxicology laboratory of the Medical University of Vienna. "Integrated Drug Checking" was offered at events, parties, and festivals.
- 2000: additional web-based psychosocial counseling (telephone and online counseling)
- 2007: opening of Homebase (on-site personal advice, specialist staff)
- 2019: start of on-site drug checking at Homebase
- 2020: start of drug checking via participating Viennese pharmacies

• Innsbruck/Tyrol: Drogenarbeit Z6

 2014: start of on-site drug checking in collaboration with the Innsbruck forensic medicine department; also streetwork

Graz/Styria: Triptalks

- 2022: on-site only via Caritas Kontaktladen and Streetwork
