## The PPRI network



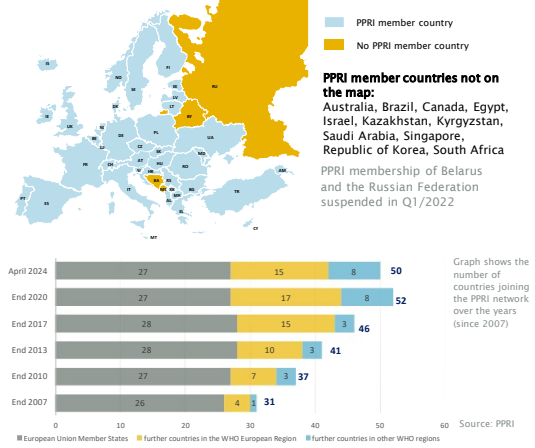
### WHO?

- A network of **competent authorities** for pharmaceutical pricing and reimbursement information from 50 countries & European and international institutions (EC, OECD, WHO)
- Led by the **PPRI Secretariat** affiliated to the Pharmacoeconomics Department at the Austrian National Public Health Institute (Gesundheit Österreich / GÖG)
- PPRI Advisory Board** of PPRI members (country representation on a rotation basis; European & international institutions)

32 F2F meetings

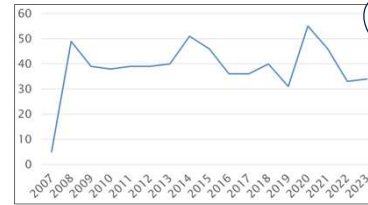
